      - Barry County Health Department – **Emergency Public Health declaration effective June 30 – December 31, 2020**
        - **Phase 2 Mitigation Rules in effect July 16 – December 31, 2020**
        - **Modified quarantine guidelines for students as of November 24, 2020**
    - Missouri - Governor Parsons declared an State wide emergency on March 13, 2020
    - United States – President Trump declared a National emergency on March 13, 2020
