The Health Department divides food service code violations into two categories; Priority and Core items.

Priority items are more likely than other violations to contribute to food contamination, or illness and/or injury.

Core items although important to the overall hygiene of the establishment, do not necessarily present an immediate threat to food contamination or illness and/or injury.

A report for each establishment that is inspected shows the number of priority items, along with a short statement as to the nature of the violations. The report also shows the number of core items, but doesn't list the nature of those violations.

4. Corn salad, sliced turkey, sliced roast beef, bean salad, and macaroni salad are not labeled with the seven day discard date. *
5. Nine packages of raw chicken, four chicken salad wraps, six packages of ground beef, and six packages of mac'n'cheese with a discard date of 6/29, six packages of mac'n'cheese with a discard date of 6/09 and a container of fajita mix with a discard date of 6/28 are not discarded.*
6. Two meals and one whole chicken from the previous day that were held by time as a public health control but were not discarded at their discard time.*
7. Can opener blade is soiled by food debris and one knife in the meat department, put away as clean, soiled by food debris.*
